DANIEL MORGAN, Brigadier General, 1736-1802, Williamsburg Lodge No. 6 Va. While executing a strategic withdrawal before the superior forces of Colonel Tarlton, Dan became aware that he could not elude Tarlton. He chose the high ground of the Cowpens to establish his defense. His plan has been described as the most brilliant military maneuver of the Revolutionary War. American losses 12 killed and 60 wounded, enemy casualties 100 killed and 229 wounded with 33 British officers killed and 27 wounded. Morgan is notable in the paintings of the Revolution for his wearing of pure white fringed buckskin clothing.

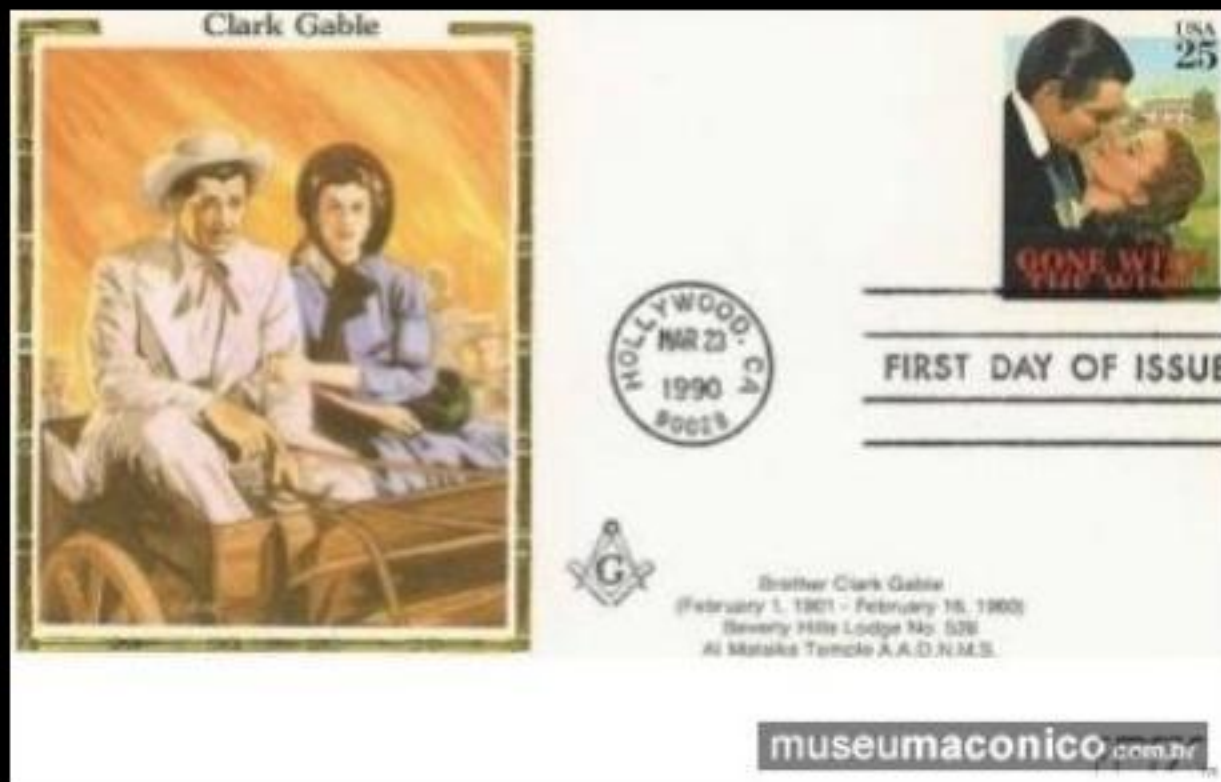

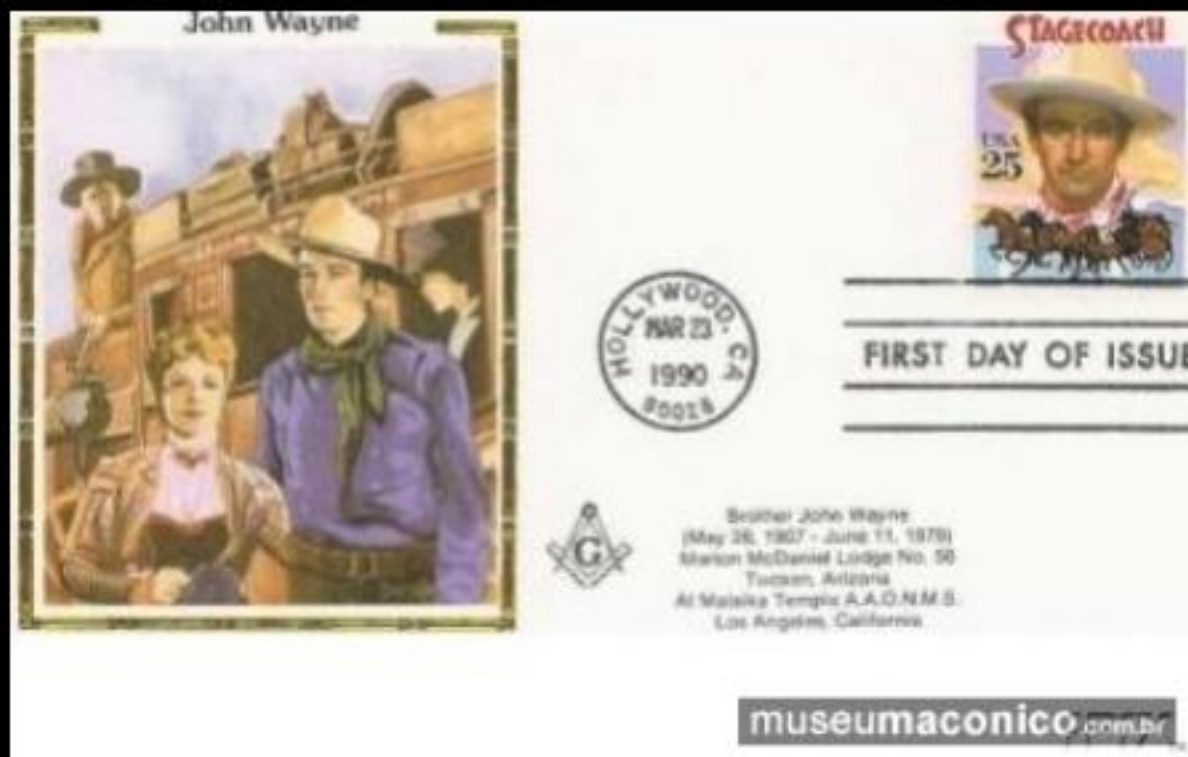

MOON LANDING—U. S. A.

The 10-cent airmail stamp commemorating man's first landing on the moon, printed from the master die which actually landed on the moon, was placed on sale in Washington, D. C. with appropriate first-day ceremonies on September 9, 1969.

Apollo 11 was the climax of an eight-year goal set by the late President John F. Kennedy, who in his message to Congress on May 25, 1961, said: "Whatever mankind must undertake, free men must fully share."

The over-sized stamp depicts a spaceman, Brother Edwin E. Aldrin, Jr., stepping from the LM space capsule onto the moon's surface on July 20, 1969. Brother Aldrin was the commander of the LM (Eagle) capsule; Astronaut Collins was the

GEORGE WASHINGTON—THE MASON	
NOVEMBER 4, 1752	Initiated into "The Lodge at Fredericksburgh", now Lodge No. 4, Fredericksburg, Virginia.
MARCH 3, 1753	Passed a Fellow Craft.
AUGUST 4, 1753	Elected a Master Mason.
JUNE 24, 1754	Made Honorary Member of Lodge No. 39 at Alexandria, Virginia, then under jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania.
APRIL 26, 1760	Charter from the Grand Lodge of Virginia granted to Lodge No. 39 at Alexandria, Va. George Washington served as Charter Worshipful Master.
APRIL 30, 1789	Took oath of office as First President of the United States of America on the Bible of St. John's Lodge No. 1 of New York City.
SEPTEMBER 18, 1793	Took part in Masonic ceremonies of laying the cornerstone of the U. S. Capitol at Washington, D. C.
DECEMBER 14, 1799	Died, buried with Masonic funeral service.
